He also listed the topics currently covered in this app that is Network theorems, Diode circuits, Common-Emitter Amplifier, Op-amp Linear circuits, Schmitt Trigger, Oscillator based on Schmitt Trigger and digital circuits.

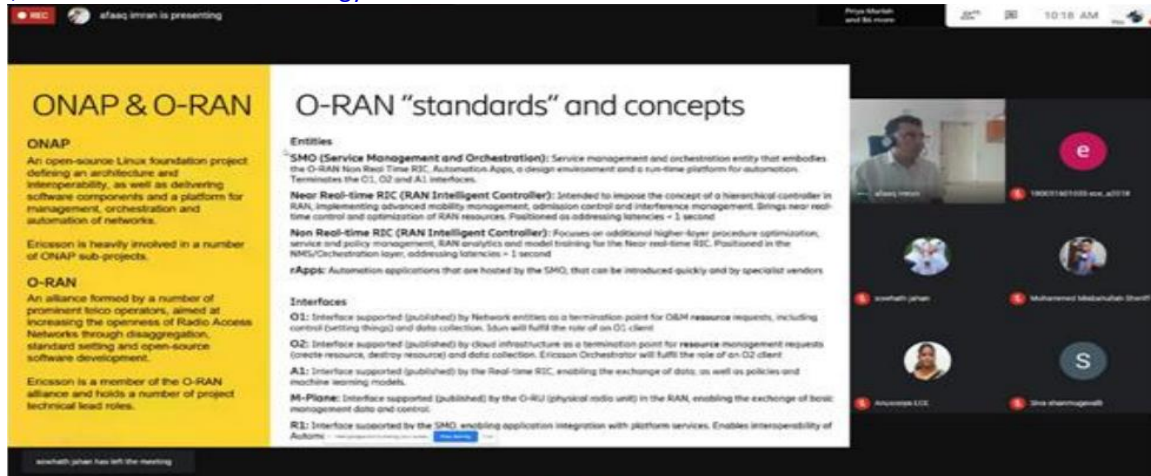

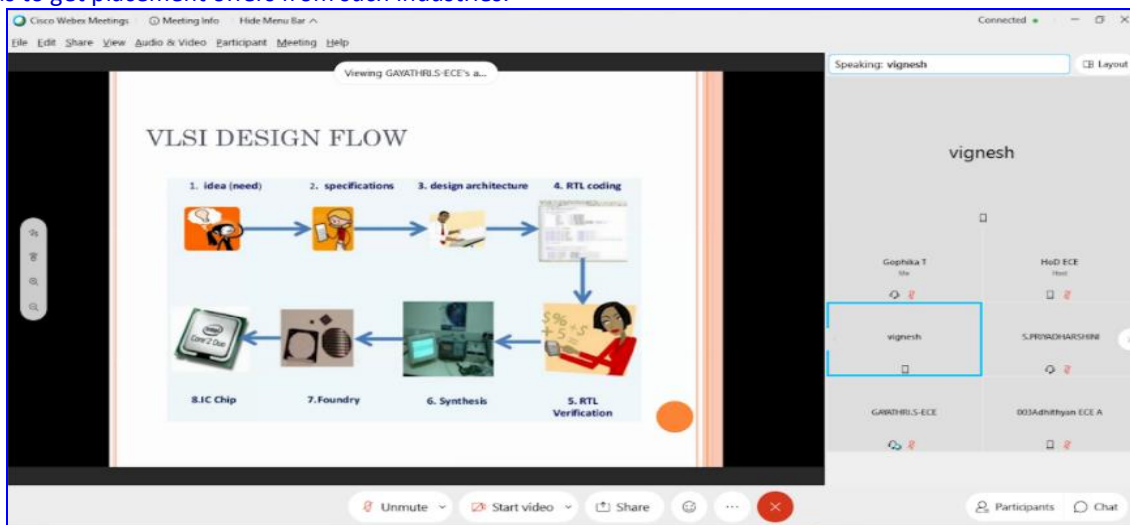

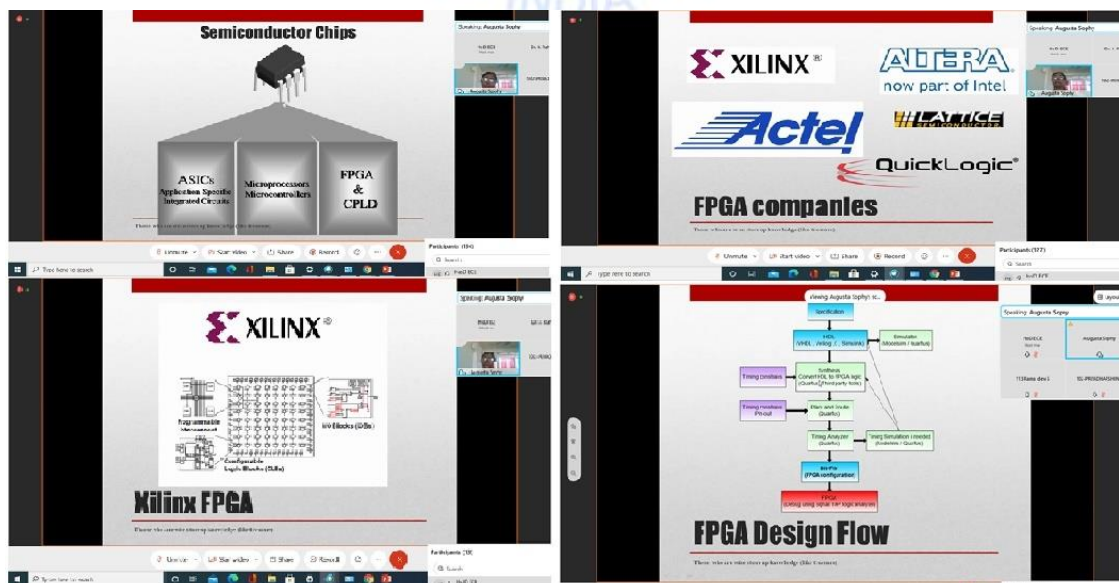
“Career Guidance Programme”

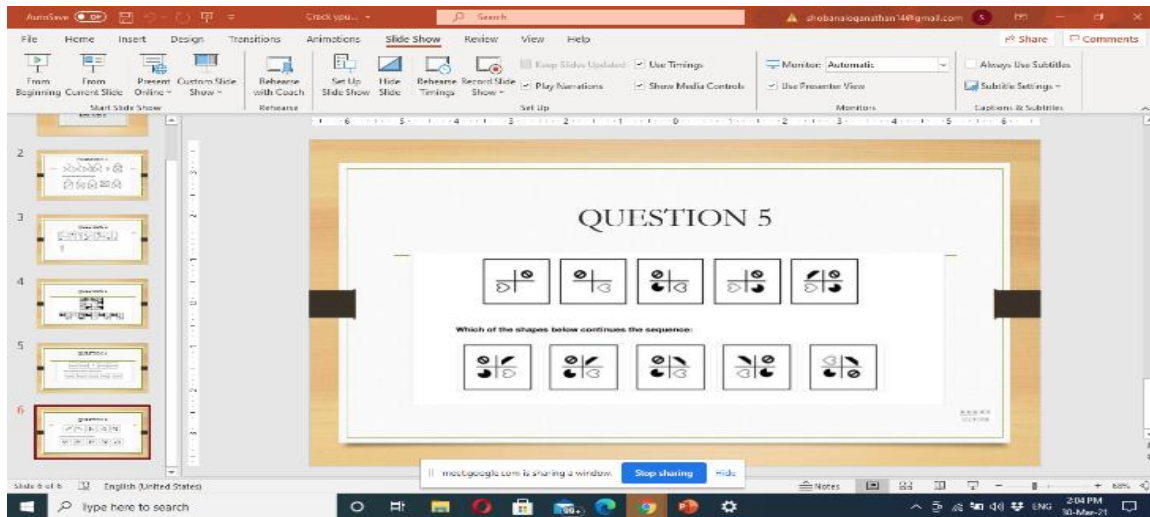

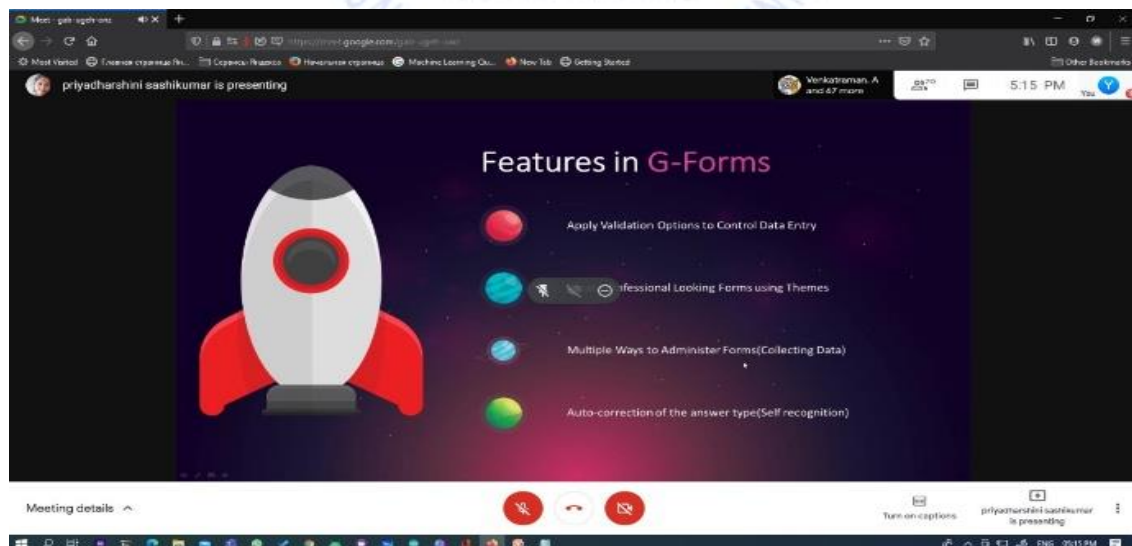
“Crack Your Mind”


“Webinar on How to create Google Forms & Auto Generate Certificates”

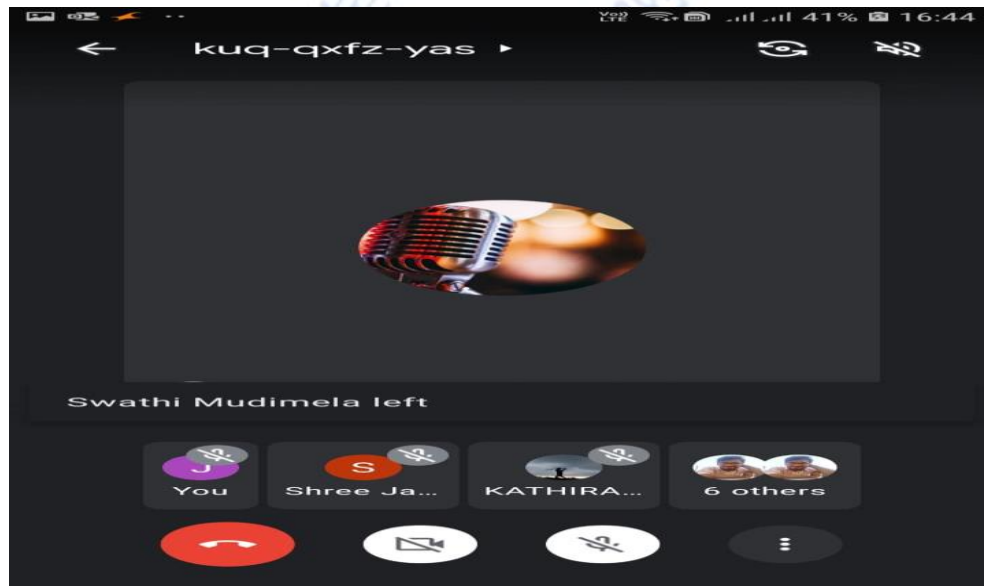

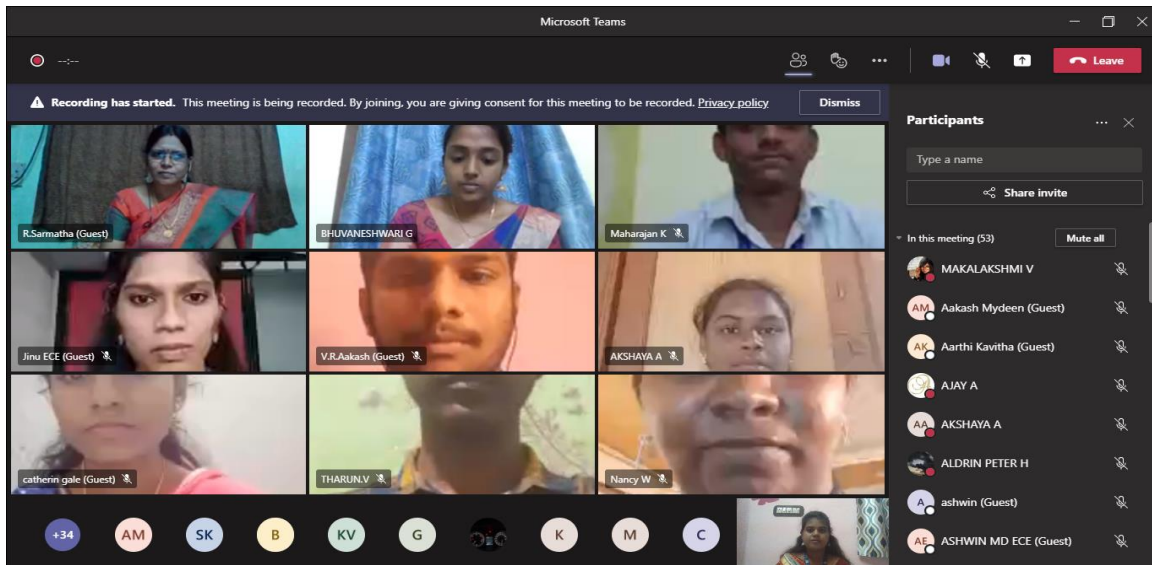
"Talk till two"

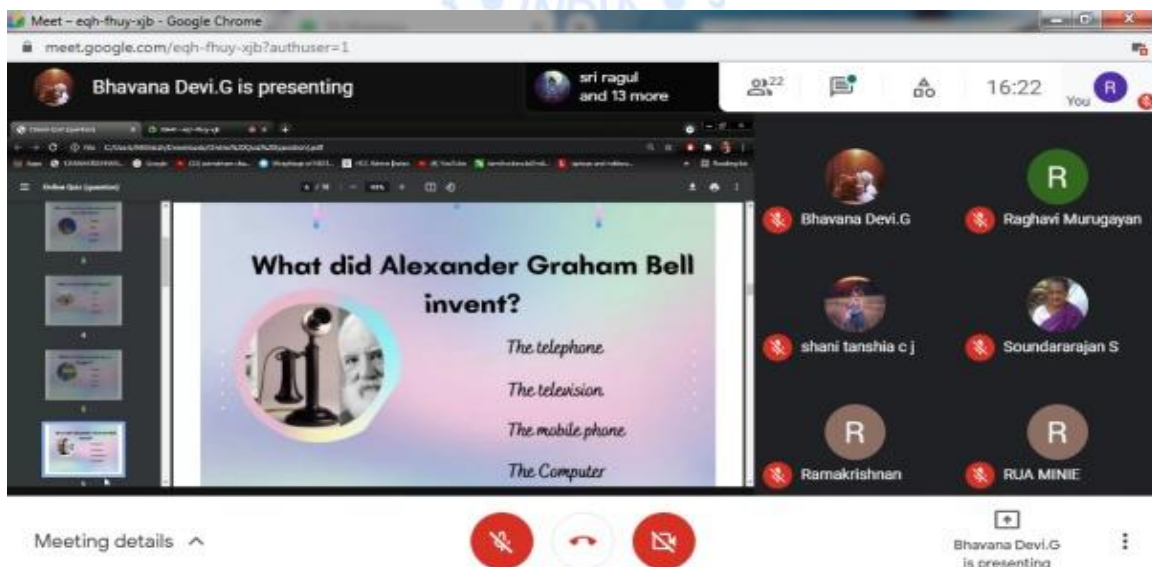
“Webinar on Design for Testability”

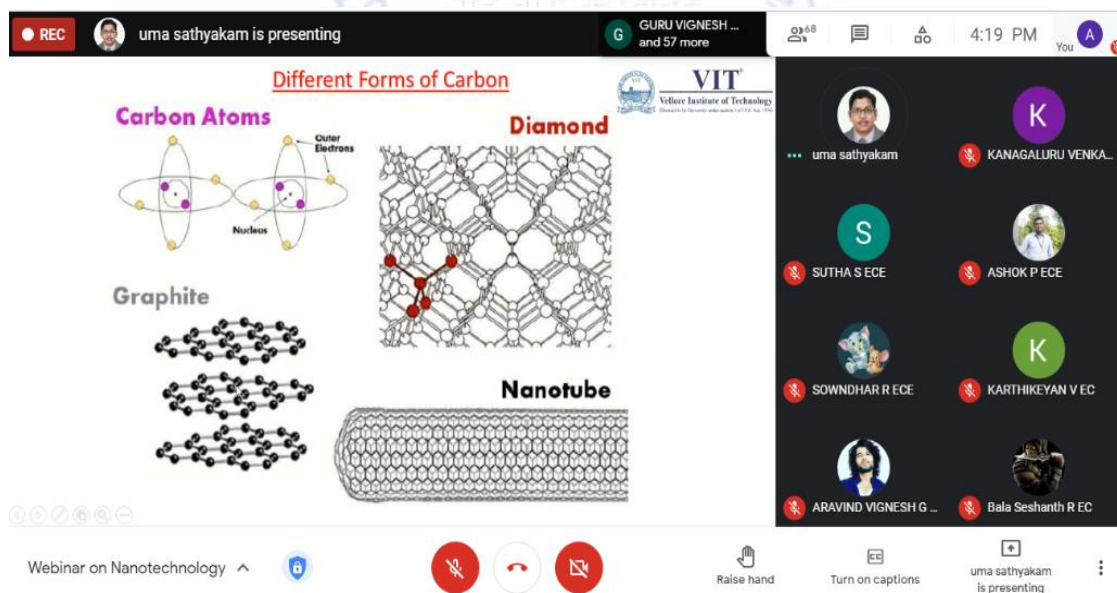
“National Conference”
